Attendance

Unexcused absences affect referee assignments; members may lose all, some, or none of their assignments, even if assignments(s) have already been accepted by the referee.

In order to be excused from a meeting, members must contact the MVSRA Secretary at least 24 hours before the scheduled meeting.

In case of an emergency, members should contact the MVSRA Secretary by phone or contact the MVSRA Commissioner.

Acceptable reasons that constitute an excused absence include:

- Previously known schedule conflicts
- Previously known family commitments or emergencies
- Work related travel or emergencies

Missing a mandatory meeting in order to referee a soccer game is not grounds for excusing absence.
