This letter is in support of Shunt DeLira's hardship that would grant him athletic eligibility. Shunt's stepfather Doug Anderson came to my office on Monday August 10, 2015 to discuss his situation with Shunt and his younger sister.

Doug shared with me that he and his wife had divorced two years ago and she had since moved to the Portland area. This summer the kid's mother (and legal guardian) moved into a house and rented 1 room from the owner because she could not afford anything else. She put the rest of her personal belongings in storage and had no place for her two kids to live. This essentially left the kids homeless. Doug's ex-wife then requested that the kids live with him in Creswell. Both students moved in with Doug in his residence in Creswell this summer.

Doug is not the legal guardian of the kids and therefor the students are not eligible to participate in athletics at Creswell without the hardship. I reviewed Shunt's transcripts and he is eligible and on track to graduate. The situation is not ideal but it was not in the student's control. I believe this case to be a true hardship. A student intent to transfer certificate was filled out and is on file at Creswell High School. Please let me know if you have any questions.
