Dear Skyline Hardship Committee Members,

I am writing this Hardship on behalf of Treyshawn Lopez who will be a sophomore at Mazama High School this coming school year.

Treyshawn moved into our district on June 1, 2015 with his court ordered legal guardian and family. This was a "Joint Family" move. He finished the year at Klamath Union High School where he was attending. He played summer league basketball with Klamath Union High School in June.

On July 20th, Tresyshawn registered for school here at Mazama High School. On July 21st a records request was sent to Klamath Union High School. On July 22nd Treyshawn participated with Mazama High School's Football team in a 7 on 7 workout. He did this without a signed Intent to Transfer form. Because this form was not signed by OSAA rule he is ineligible.

We at Mazama are requesting that he be approved to participate at Mazama High School. He moved into our attendance boundary, registered for school and requested records all before participating with his resident High School. If the Intent to Transfer form would have been signed before participation we would not even have to go through this process.
