Dear Anne:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA rules. After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that the student is not eligible at this time. However, the circumstances surrounding this situation warrant that the student's academic progress be closely monitored and eligibility will be granted on the above date if the student is meeting OSAA academic requirements at that time.

Conditions of this eligibility include the student enrolling in PCC Early College program when it starts in late September and passing ALL courses with weekly monitoring. If the student fails to enroll as a full time student in PCC Early College program when it starts, then any game he participated in prior to that must be forfeited. If at any time the student falls below this OSAA eligibility standard, eligibility will be automatically revoked for the remainder of the semester. Eligibility can be restored for the next semester if this student is meeting the OSAA requirement at the end of this semester.
