Dear Ken:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA rules. After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that the student is not eligible at this time. However, the circumstances surrounding this situation warrant that the student's academic progress be closely monitored and eligibility will be granted on the above date if the student is meeting OSAA academic requirements at that time.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be the student attending classes regularly and weekly monitoring by the school to ensure that the student is meeting the requirements of his Individualized Education Program (IEP) to maintain eligibility. He must also complete his credit recovery plan to get back on track to graduate. If the student fails to meet these goals and objectives at any time, then eligibility is revoked. Any request for future eligibility would have to be resubmitted to this office for consideration.
