The school where he was in Haiti, they required us to pay for the full year. Bernadeau's mom who lives in Haiti couldn't afford the school year and we knew that he was about to get his visa to come to the USA. That would be a waste of money for the family if they have paid the whole amount for the school when he was gonna be there just for a few months. In Haiti, there is no such thing as refund. That's why we did not let him go to school.

In haiti, in order to graduate high school, an individual needs two diplomas. You get one once you completed 11th grade and the other once you completed 12th grade. Our son has completed the 11th grade one and he has the diploma to show for it. He has not complete the requirement for the 12th grade one. Our son is dying to play soccer for the school and we hope this letter explains what were not clear to you guys.
