Transfer without joint move of residence and grade deficiency.

Daniel has transferred to Churchill High School from Alliance High School in Portland. Alliance High School is an alternative school that mainly services Seniors and super seniors.

Daniel started his freshman year at DeLasalle High School in Portland. He played football for Grant High School because his private school doesn't offer football.

During the football season, Daniel was involved in an incident that included getting tazed. This incident is still in the court system. Daniel was involved in two tazing incidents his freshman year, both on the receiving end.

I contacted Grant High School concerning the incident. Because the case is still pending, no one is willing to confirm or deny the allegations. They did confirm that an incident did take place.

The principal at Alliance High School confirmed that Daniel had difficulty at their institution because he was an incoming freshman surrounded by 18-20 year olds.

Daniel's uncle offered to allow Daniel to move in with him and his wife in Eugene in order to provide a safe environment and get a fresh start. He is currently practicing with the football team and would like to continue participate.

We would like to put Daniel on academic probation and monitor him weekly in order to maintain eligibility to participate. If at any time, his attendance or academic standing falls short of our expectations, his participation in games would be revoked.

Both the Vice Principal/Football Coach from Grant and the Principal from Alliance High School supported Daniel's move and wish him well when I talked to them over the phone.

We believe Daniel has been the victim of peer harassment during his Freshman year at two different academic institutions. We believe he deserves a fresh start at a new school and support his decision to participate in athletics only while maintaining academic progress towards graduation.
