

We as a coaching staff teach and mentor our kids in more than just football. We talk about respecting one another, their parents, teachers, classmates, and opponents, officials, etc. and work on being a better person every day. However, unfortunately, last year was very rough for us as family and for him as the oldest child in the family. I was diagnosed with breast cancer and having to go treatments which affecting my ability to care for the house, my 4 years old daughter. I also had to work graveyard shift to be able to provide for my family financially since I am the sole provider for my family. My ex husband is not involved in our life due to domestic violence; my children and I are DV survivors. I have sole custody of my children.

I also signed my boys; Zaccary and Josiah to Football because they love the sport. It appears that they are very fond of the whole team and feel very welcomed. I am humbly asking to allow Zaccary to participate in the Football game. Zaccary accepted the consequences of his bad grades but I feel he should be given a chance since it was not entirely his fault.
