This letter is for the purpose of applying for eligibility for Jesus (Jessie) A. Gonzales.


Jessie is currently enrolled as a full-time student at Rogue River High School. Prior to the 2015-16 academic year, he was enrolled at New Hope Christian School for all of his freshman and sophomore years (2012-13 and 2013-14). He was not enrolled for the first semester during his junior year but reenrolled for the second semester.

During his freshman and sophomore years, he accumulated 12 credits and in his junior year he earned 3.75 credits. He currently has a total of 15.75. This total is short of the requirement to have earned 17 credits upon entering his senior year.

Jessie did not attend school during the first semester of his junior year because he was "no longer welcome in his father's home in Rogue River" and left to live with his mother in California. While in California, he enrolled in school but soon left to help support his mother and also made some bad choices. He eventually came back to Oregon and re-enrolled at New Hope.

In conclusion, I am requesting that Jessie's athletic eligibility be reinstated. As with other student/athletes at Rogue River, he will be expected to adhere to eligibility rules in regards to progression to graduation and classes passed each quarter. I will be monitoring his progress as he continues to get back on track to graduate with his class.
