Dear Brent:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA rules. After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that the student is not eligible at this time. However, the circumstances surrounding this situation warrant that the student's academic progress be closely monitored and eligibility will be granted on the above date if the student is meeting OSAA academic requirements at that time.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school of the student's grades for the remainder of this semester and the student must be passing ALL classes each week, he must be attending school regularly (no unexcused absences), and he must complete his credit recovery plan as outlined so that he gets back on track toward graduation and is able to graduate in June 2017. If at any time the student fails to meet these requirements, eligibility will be automatically revoked for the remainder of the semester. Eligibility can be restored for the next semester if this student is meeting the OSAA requirement at the end of this semester.
