

Re: Treyshawn Holland

I am writing this letter of hardship for Treyshawn Holland. Treyshawn is requesting to play football for Jefferson this year but did not pass the minimum number of classes last June 2015. Treyshawn did meet the standard for total credits towards graduation prior to his junior year. The last two years Treyshawn has struggled with a unstable home life. Treyshawn did not make it to school for various reasons. His mom has filed and received Title X status from Portland Public Schools. Portland Public Schools Title X Homeless Education program exists for those students that do not have a fixed regular and adequate living situation. See attached letter from Treyshawn's mom, Barbara Allen. Treyshawn has shown that with academic support from his football coaches he does better in school. For year the past two years Treyshawn's grades have dropped the second half of the year when Treyshawn is not participating in sports. Participation in the Jefferson football program would help provide Treyshawn with a positive supportive environment. Treyshawn is currently attending all his classes and has 1 tardy. See Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> attendance report. Treyshawn is working with his SEI, "Self Enhancement" coordinator, Aanen Trelstad on a plan to graduate on time. I have also attached letters from the Jefferson football coaches in support of Treyshawn. Jefferson High School can provide Treyshawn with tutoring services in partnership with Portland Community College and Self Enhancement. The Jefferson athletic programs are one more layer of support that can truly motivate our students.
