

To Whom It May Concern:


I Anna Holloway am writing to dispute the ineligibility of my daughter Emaleigh Sizemore in OSAA sports program at Douglas High School. While I agree that her current GPA is unacceptable by any standards, I feel that she has some extenuating circumstances that need to be looked into.

Emaleigh made a decision to live with her father last year. While I was unable to monitor her grades her first semester her grades were acceptable. Upon entering the second semester Emaleigh was dealing with extreme depression. At that time she was causing self harm by cutting. Emaleigh was unable to function at the level that she is accustomed to. Her schoolwork suffered due to this illness.

Emaleigh made the decision to move home in late July 2015. She has since been seeking medical attention to address the depression. She is currently taking an antidepressant and seeing a therapist. She has already shown that she is getting better.

I feel that keeping Emaleigh out of a sport that she loves and is interacting in a healthy environment will only hinder the progress she has already made. I am open to any type of plan to monitor her progress academically. If she is not able to keep her grades at an acceptable level at anytime during the upcoming school year, I feel that this would be an appropriate time to implement the ineligibility clause. If proof of treatment and medication is needed, I will acquire the appropriate documentation.
