His girlfriend caught him getting drunk and then using online dating sights and the broke up and he is back to his old ways doing stuff he shouldn't be doing.

My mom being a single parent is trying to find the best job that she can to work to make money for her and her kids and she works all the time she works from the morning all the way till the night and I don't really see her that much and when I need help with homework she can't really help me because she isn't home.

I have worked really hard to get my grades up and To fix this problem that I have and I learned my mistakes and I'm gonna get my work 100% done this year with no issues! I hope for the best and I'm so glad I got these glasses done so that I am on track to graduate! Thank you so much
