Dear Hardship Committee

I am writing this letter on behalf of Andrew Hampton. Andrew transferred to Klamath Union High School from North High School in Bakersfield California. Andrew attended his ninth and tenth grades at North H.S. When Andrew completed his ninth grade at North He was a student in good standing with a 3 point GPA and was athletically involved. As Andrew progressed to the tenth grade, he dropped sports and his grades began diminishing, this worsened his second semester.

In speaking with mom, she has stated that Andrews biological father stepped back into his life and began communicating with Andrew during his sophomore year. His father has only been around Andrew very few times and when he does step into his life, it has had negative consequences on Andrew emotionally. After these brief encounters the father removes himself from Andrews's life leaving Andrew and his mother to deal with the emotional aftermath.

Andrew had a high absentee rate also during his sophomore year due to two injuries, one a broken ankle, and two a broken nose, which resulted in surgery. Additionally Andrew made some poor choices because of his biological fathers influence.

At the end of Andrews's sophomore year, his mother decided to move with her family to Oregon to remove herself from encounters with Andrews's father.

I have met with Andrew and his mother and had a long conversation regarding what he needs to do to get back on track and correct his academic position. Andrew is a pleasant young man who had a good beginning to his high school career. He has had no behavioral problems and never had negative interactions with teachers and school staff. Andrew is willing to do what is necessary to maintain good academic standing and complete high school on time with his cohort class.

Converting his California credits to Oregon standards, he has nine credits, three short of being on track. I have meet with his academic counselor and we have placed him in classes to insure the best possible success, additionally he has been enrolled in online Aventa classes to make up classes and be at 18 credits at the end of his junior year, which would result in being back on track for graduation. I have arranged with Toni Kellom, the director of Klamath Institute (Klamath Falls City Schools alternative program) for Andrew to attend evening tutorials at KI if necessary to help in achieving academic success for Andrew.
