Hi Kate & Yesta,

Martin Anema attended your school last year and has transferred to our high school in Ashland, Oregon for his junior year. He wants to play soccer but is currently an ineligible transfer because he did not move here with his family. He is currently living with his aunt and uncle in our district. They report that he was having conflict with his parents and was having trouble in Denver so they felt him moving here could give him a fresh start. He initially came for a visit over the summer and then they decided it was best for him to stay.

We are applying for a hardship eligibility for him and need something from the school he left to say that you have no knowledge of him being recruited. It would also be helpful if you gave support for the move.

Yesta: He said that you have knowledge of his circumstances last year and could speak to what his challenges were. No need to go into detail, just acknowledgement that a fresh start might be a good thing for him (if you believe that to be true).

A short response to this email by one or both of you will suffice for what we need to help this kid out. He will be a JV player for us so no competitive advantage, just trying to do what is best for him. Thanks!
