Athletic Director Rub:

This letter is in support of Trevor Tucker and his eligibility to participate in athletics at Astoria High School. I have met with Trevor and discussed his academic and personal challenges over the previous school year. We have developed a graduation plan that will keep him on track to meet all Astoria High School graduation requirements by June 2016 and graduate on time with his class. This plan will require sustained focus and effort by Trevor as well as substantial work to be completed outside of the school day. I believe that Tucker's participation in athletics will support his academic goals and personal well-being, however it will be essential that his academic progress is monitored and kept the top-priority if his current graduation plan is to be a success.

I recommend that he attend tutorial sessions and his grades and attendance be monitored by the athletic department on a regular basis (i.e. weekly) to ensure that he receives the necessary support and is provided with academic and/or personal-social intervention should he find himself facing similar difficulties as in the previous semester.
