Jacob Hull is a Junior at Churchill High School and wants to participate in Soccer.

He is currently ineligible due to the fact that he is not on track to graduate.

At the end of his Sophomore year, Jacob had earned 6.5 credits.

Over the summer, Jacob passed two classes and earned an additional 1.0 credit.

He now has 7.5 credits and is 2.5 credits short of being on Track to graduate.

Jacob has been enrolled with a full schedule of 5 classes for the past two weeks.

His attendance has been excellent and is doing very well in all classes. His progress report is attached.

Jacob has a plan to graduate on time by doing the following:

Junior Year class load: 5 classes first trimester, 6 classes second and third trimester.
