This letter is in regards to Davide Ribioldi from Italy, an international high school student on program with AFS USA. He is on an AFS program for one year.

AFS USA's mission and purpose is to build bridges of understanding between cultures to create a more just and peaceful world. All the students who apply to go on an AFS program do so for the purpose of experiencing another culture and sharing their own with the community they are assigned. No student gets to decide what country they will end up in, nor do they decide what family they will be hosted with. In Davide's case, he applied to go on program in America, and two other countries. He was selected by AFS USA to come to America, because of his English speaking skills and his willingness to be open and share his own culture with an American community.

The Department of State gives AFS USA a deadline to find homes for each of our students. In no way was Davide's placement planned on anything but the fact that the Davis's were willing to host a student who otherwise would not come on an exchange program. Davide was slated to be hosted in Iowa, but no family was found to host. The Davis's were generous enough to say "yes" and host Davide for the cultural experience and from the goodness of their hearts. No AFS USA family is paid to host. They are volunteers. They provide all the necessities they would their own child as a host family.

His placement was based on the willingness of the Davis family to host him and care for him while he is in America on a cultural and academic experience only, nothing more.
