Dear Petra:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1 (Grade Deficiency) and OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that there is sufficient evidence to grant eligibility at this time. Documentation has been submitted to indicate that the school has put the student on a credit recovery program that will enable the student to be able to graduate on schedule.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school of the student's grades, the student must pass ALL classes each week, attending school regularly (no unexcused absences), and completing his credit recovery classes to make up the classes that were not passed last year. The student must do enough credit recovery (summer school, night school, or online) to be back on track toward graduation by the start of the 2016-17 school year. If at any time the student falls below this OSAA eligibility standard, eligibility will be automatically revoked for the remainder of the semester.

It is our sincere hope that this waiver will be of benefit to the student.
