She was told she could not because she only had two credits last semester making her credit deficient. I would like to say that she is not credit deficient, she was already ahead with 3.75 credits from the first semester. Due to several factors, she was only able to attain 2.0 credits in the second semester.

We moved in the middle of last school year. One of her previous schools the Redmond Proficiency Academy would allow students to take as many classes as they wanted. This allowed her to get ahead of what was needed for the semester.
