Dear Jon:

I have received the updated Eligibility Request that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1 (Grade Deficiency). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that there is sufficient evidence to grant eligibility at this time. Documentation has been submitted to support the claim that the academic deficiency is primarily due to circumstances beyond the control of the student, the student's parents, or both.

The student has been diagnosed with a learning disability (Attention Deficit Disorder – ADD) and has started medication for his condition. His intellectual abilities are significantly lower than average. The student is eligible through his scheduled meeting on Friday, February 5, 2016 to determine his formal eligibility for Special Education Services. If it is determined that he qualifies under "Other Health Impairment" with a diagnosis of ADD, the student will remain eligible under the conditions listed below.

The conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school to insure the student is attending school regularly (NO unexcused absences), he is exhibiting satisfactory effort in all classes, he is passing all classes after his IEP has been put into place, and completing his graduation plan as presented by his counselor (including four summer school courses) so that he graduates in June 2017. If at any time the student falls below this OSAA eligibility standard, eligibility will be automatically revoked for the remainder of the semester.

It is our sincere hope that this waiver will be of benefit to the student.
