Dear Damian:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1 (Grade Deficiency). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that there is sufficient evidence to grant eligibility at this time. Documentation has been submitted to support the claim that the academic deficiency is primarily due to circumstances beyond the control of the student, the student's parents, or both.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school of the student's grades and the student must pass ALL classes each week. The student must also be attending school regularly (NO unexcused absences).

As per OSAA Rule 8.2, this is the final year of eligibility for this student. "A student may participate in the interscholastic program for four consecutive years (eight semesters or the equivalent) after entering the 9th grade." His four consecutive years of eligibility will expire after the 2015-16 school year.

If at any time the student falls below this OSAA eligibility standard, eligibility will be automatically revoked for the remainder of the semester. Eligibility can be restored for the next semester if this student is meeting the OSAA requirement at the end of this semester.

It is our sincere hope that this waiver will be of benefit to the student.
