



Then my mom got sick and passed away within weeks. And then grades started to drop and he went down hill. I started counseling and took him to the doctors for depression. But he still had a hard time. And then about a year and  $\frac{1}{2}$  after we lost my mom. My dad had a major heart attack in front of both my kids and died in my boyfriend's arms. Caleb continued to go down hill. At the beginning of 10<sup>th</sup> grade he asked to be put back in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Because he did so bad the year before (but still did poorly). Then during the summer he started to talk about sports again. And said he wanted to play football again. When school started we checked (to see if there was anyway he could play). But he couldn't because of his grades. He then said he wanted to play basketball. I told him his grades and attitude had to change. Or I wouldn't check to see if he could play. He told me he would work on it. At parent conferences, I went in with a knot in my stomach. Ready for bad news. I ended up leaving in tears (good ones). All of his teachers told me how much he has changed (attitude, work, etc). And how good he is doing. Don't get me wrong he still has his moments. I would like to say he does nothing wrong. But I know better and that wouldn't help him. He did bring his grades up and they are passing. He is back to his old self again. He is really wanting to play basketball and I hope this tells you a little about what has been going on. He is a great kid and a unbelievable athlete. Caleb has worked hard to show that he wants this. And said he plans on doing what he needs to.

Because he wants to play football next year, I hope this letter helps. I would love to see him play. Not just for me but for Caleb too. Thanks for your time.
