He told me he would work on it. At parent conferences, I went in with a knot in my stomach. Ready for bad news. I ended up leaving in tears (good ones). All of his teachers told me how much he has changed (Attitude, work, ect). And how good he is doing. Don't get me wrong he still has his moments. I would like to say he does nothing wrong. But I know better and that wouldn't help him. He did bring his grades up and they are passing. He is back to his old self again. He is really wanting to play basketball and I hope this tells you a little about what has been going on. He is a great kid and a unbelievable Athlete. Caleb has worked hard to show that he wants this. And said he plans on doing what he needs to.

Because he wants to play football next year, I hope
this letter helps. I would love to see him play. Not
