If a waiver is denied by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board, an appeal can be made to a Hearings Officer under OSAA Handbook Rule 9, "Hearings Officer." Appeals to the Hearings Officer shall include an appeal fee of \$250.

Brooks Kimball is a senior at Hidden Valley High School. He currently needs 10.14 credits to graduate. He is currently enrolled in 7 classes that will give him 7 credits toward graduation. He is currently passing all of his classes. This will leave him with 3.14 credits remaining. I have enrolled him in Odyssey Ware (our on-line courses) for 2.0 credits of science and 1.0 credit of World History. He is working on these classes after school. He has .5 credit of Work Experience completed that will be placed on the transcript once the paperwork is processed. If he is allowed to wrestle he will also receive .5 elective for sports. I will adjust his schedule as these credits are transcribed to give him more time during school to work on Odyssey Ware. This will give him the 25.5 credits that he needs to graduate this year with his class.

The follow is a plan for Brooks to complete this year:

7.0 credits from HVHS classes

2.0 Science credits from Odyssey Ware

1.0 World History credit

0.5 Sports credit

0.5 Work Experience credit

11 credits (schedule will be adjusted for a total of Total 10.14 credits)

Brooks has been in several high schools due to past problems. However, he has shown himself to be a solid student here at HVHS and he is making every effort to get himself back on track. I believe it in his best interest for him to be allowed to participate in wrestling this year. I am confident Brooks will do the work and graduate.

Dear District Athletic Committee

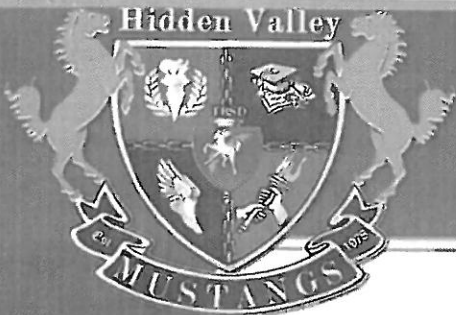
I am writing this letter in support of Brooks Kimball a senior that started at Hidden Valley High School at the beginning of this school year. Brooks came to us from Bob Belloni Ranch where he attended in 2014-15 school year. Before this he was at Newbridge High School in Grants Pass which is a youth correctional facility. In 2013, he was at Robert Farrell School which is part of the Hillside Youth Correctional facility. In 2012, Brooks attend Barlow High School as a freshmen and he did not do very well as he passed 4 out of 14 classes.

I do not know much about Brooks Kimball's past but I know he did get into some trouble after attending Barlow High School. From there he attended two different youth correctional facilities and has done very well academically. At the Bob Belloni Ranch he passed 15 out of 15 classes. When he left the BB Ranch his parents deserted him and only his grandma came to pick him up and this is where he currently resides.

Brooks has a weighted gpa of 1.35 but last year's gpa was a 2.75 which is a great improvement. Currently at Hidden Valley, Brooks is excelling socially, mentally, emotionally and acracically. At the quarter grading period Brooks has: 2-A's, 3-B's, 2 very high C's as you will see on his progress report.

Brooks is not on track to graduate by the OSAA requirements and Mr. Farmer his counselor and I have put together a plan for him to graduate. Currently Brooks is meeting all his requirements. He is passing all his current classes and also is making up classes after school using Odysseyware (our online program for students to make up classes) which he is on track.

I have attached a letter from Mr. Farmer outlining how we will keep Brooks on track to graduate with his class in June of 2016. We will be tracking Brooks with weekly progress reports and also tracking his online classes as well. This plan has worked very well in the

I got set to detention when I was 13 years old for reason i do not wish to tell. I was in detention for two months, and then got sent to a boy's home in Troutdale, Portland. I was at Sam Barlow High School and was pushed around and bullied. From that happening I was not happy and my grades dropped. Since my grades dropped I had to go to a boy's facility in Salem. I then got enrolled into Robert Ferrill. This facility was a temporary placement for kids who do what they are supposed to do. This includes having good grades in school and listening to my authority figures.

I was only in this facility for one months, because i was doing what i was supposed to do and working hard. Then i was sent to another boy's facility in grants pass, and enrolled Newbridge High School. I was in this Facility for nine months trying to prove my ability to follow the directions and to act accordingly. I had all mid to high grades at Newbridge.

After I completed this facility i got sent to a final boy's home to be able to rejoin the community. Same with this school i had all passing grades. I was able to demonstrate traits like leadership. After i completed the program I had the highest levels in my class.

I finally have been placed at my grandmother's house. I tried to enroll into summer school but since i was enrolled into Three Rivers School District, I was not able to participate in the summer school programs. I am currently starting Odyssey courses to get my remaining 2 credits.
