

Appeals of decisions made by the District Athletic Committee are heard by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board. Appeals must be requested in writing, or e-mail, and submitted to the OSAA Executive Director.

Any party filing an appeal of a decision made by the District Athletic Committee to the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board shall be assessed a filing fee of \$100 to defray the costs to the Association of assembling the respective appeals bodies to hear the appeal.

If a waiver is denied by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board, an appeal can be made to a Hearings Officer under OSAA Handbook Rule 9, "Hearings Officer." Appeals to the Hearings Officer shall include an appeal fee of \$250.



We are submitting this hardship request for Carlos Chavez. Carlos is a 17 year old senior in good academic standing and on track to graduate.

The hardship for Carlos exists due to his relationship with his mother and his inability to live at home with his biological parents who reside in Tulelake California. There have been ongoing relationship challenges with his biological parents for years and he was kicked out of his parents' home in October.

Carlos has moved during his high school tenure between Tulelake California where his biological parents reside and Victorville California east of Los Angeles where his grandparents reside. His grandparents are the legal guardian for Carlos.

In October, Carlos moved to the Lost River attendance area and is residing with a 70 year old male who is a friend of the family where he rents a room. He has chosen this option due to not being able to reside with his parents in Tulelake and concerns with school and the environment he was exposed in Victorville.

Carlos is a good academic student for the many times he has moved between Tulelake and Victorville and carries a current 2.13 gpa. Carlos meets the criteria for homeless under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act and is currently receiving support from this organization in Klamath Falls.

Carlos has participated in basketball in the past in Victorville and in Tulelake. He is requesting to be declared eligible to participate and join the Lost River basketball team.

It was towards the end of my sophomore year that I went back to the high school I attended my freshman year (Silverado High School) because my legal guardians(Grandma &Grandpa) felt I was unable to live with my mother anymore due to my mom having a plethora of personal problems. I attended Oak Hills High School just across town from Silverado because they had a better reputation; And It was far away from the gang violence as well, Silverado was known for having a lot of gang activity so I transferred to a safer environment.

After Oak Hills I came back to Tulelake, for personal reasons. Even though my mother has a lot of problems, I wanted to be there to watch my little brother grow up and my father is like my bestfriend. Unfortunately, things went the same direction as they did the first time I lived with my parents. My mother had a breakdown and I moved in with a family friend for the sake of me having a peaceful home. Our family friend Larry Pershin, who took me in ,lives in Oregon and I was attending school at a California High School at the time. Tulelake notified me that it was best that I transfer to Lost River because I lived out of state. My father and Grandparents decided that attending lost river would be the best option for my education and future, and I would have to agree with them. Lost River has helped me tremendously, they gave me the opportunity to get educated, and it is a good learning environment here. I have a clear mind and a peaceful home now. I don't have any trouble at school or any trouble at home. And I have been given the opportunity here at Lost River to do what I love, and that is to play basketball. Basketball has been my escape throughout the hard times and throughout all the family issues I've been through. I hope to get the opportunity to help and contribute to the Lost River basketball team. It would be the highlight of my senior year and something I could look back on and be proud of.
