It has come to my attention that Sabina Villalba-Botello's hardship has been denied due to some missing factors. Well I am hoping that I can help with that. I am Sabina's Oregon Youth Authority Probation Officer and she was placed on probation with the Oregon Youth Authority on 7/17/13 for reasons that I can't state do to client confidentiality. What I can share with you is that Sabina was placed in her current foster home because her home/family are not an option due to inappropriate supervision, family gang/drug/criminal involvement and all around not a safe place for her to be. Sabina has been doing extremely well and working very hard at her current placement and has definitely earned the right to participate in sports. Unfortunately the Oregon Youth Authority does not pay for its youth to participate in sports and Sabina does not have the means to pay for it herself and that is why I believe the hardship was sent. Since being on probation Sabina has not had any issues at school with teachers, peers, or grades so I have never had any concerns with her participating in school sports.
