Your OSAA Student Eligibility Request Form has been returned as insufficient. You are asked to provide additional information and re-submit the form. Tom Welter - OSAA Staff has included the following notes as to the reason for your form's rejection. Student only has accumulated 5 credits after two years of high school. He needs to obtain 19 credits during the next two years in order to graduate. While he is currently passing 5 classes please submit a detailed credit recovery schedule showing what courses he is going to take and when he is going to complete them so that he can graduate in June 2017. Why is he not already taking credit recovery courses (last summer and currently). While this student has some additional responsibilities when living with his mother it appears that he made many poor choices regarding attending school and doing the required work to pass some classes. I need to see how he will possibly obtain 19 credits between now and June 2017.

This form is seeking a hardship waiver for Amir Walker to be eligible to participate at Aloha High School for the 2015-16 school year. A decision cannot be made until you address the insufficiencies and re-submit your form.
