Dear Todd:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that eligibility should not be granted at this time.

Eligibility is denied because the student has failed to demonstrate sufficient academic achievement at this time, and the student has not established this deficiency is due to circumstances beyond the control of each of the student and the student's parent(s). This student was not eligible prior to suffering her concussion. She was not making satisfactory progress toward graduation after her sophomore year as she had only accumulated 8 credits (out of a minimum requirement of 10 credits). She will need to pass all of her second semester classes this spring, as well as complete credit recovery classes online, and attend summer school to accumulate at least 17 total credits in order to be eligible at the start of the 2016-17 school year.

You have a right to appeal my decision to the OSAA Executive Board. If you would like to schedule an appeal, please forward a written request to the OSAA office. As per OSAA Executive Board Policy "Eligibility Appeal Filing Fee", there is a non-refundable \$100.00 filing fee to defray the costs of the appeal.
