I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that there is sufficient evidence to grant eligibility at this time. Documentation has been submitted to indicate that the school has put the student on a credit recovery program that will enable the student to be able to graduate on schedule.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be the school's weekly monitoring of the student's academic progress. Also, the student must be attending school regularly (NO unexcused absences), passing ALL 7 classes each week, as well as completing his credit recovery plan as outlined (including summer school).
