1. All tests to be completed in quiet location separate from the class with additional time to complete them, open book when possible and/or take home
2. Reduced days as tolerated.
3. 25%-50% decreased in HW to allow for adequate cognitive rest.
4. Additional time to complete homework (3-5 days) assignments to accommodate for slowed speed of processing.
5. Shortened assignments and fewer choices.
6. Frequent breaks as needed. Please allow Lexus rest in the nurses office or other quiet location, allow her to have "in class" breaks, to be arranged with teachers
7. Teacher checking in with Lexus and her family periodically to discuss concerns or questions.
