



Appeals of decisions made by the District Athletic Committee are heard by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board. Appeals must be requested in writing, or e-mail, and submitted to the OSAA Executive Director.

Any party filing an appeal of a decision made by the District Athletic Committee to the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board shall be assessed a filing fee of \$100 to defray the costs to the Association of assembling the respective appeals bodies to hear the appeal.

If a waiver is denied by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board, an appeal can be made to a Hearings Officer under OSAA Handbook Rule 9, "Hearings Officer." Appeals to the Hearings Officer shall include an appeal fee of \$250.

I am writing at the request of my daughter, Lily Hasel, who is applying for an OSAA Hardship Waiver at Sheridan High School. She previously attended Eola Hills Charter School in Amity, Oregon, for four years, where she had been successful.

With a change in our schedule it has become increasingly more difficult to transport her to school. The transportation issues has fallen on members of my immediate and extended family. This combined with progress checks prompted us to make a move.

This year, her freshman year, we noticed a change. Her grades seemed to be slipping, and it became increasingly difficult for me to check her progress at school. I was unable to log in to the school's parent portal, even after resetting the account multiple times. Requesting progress reports from the teachers resulted in them sending vague, sometimes handwritten notes. After discussing it with my husband, the decision was made to move Lily to my place of employment – Sheridan High School – at the beginning of Semester 2. We felt that we would be able to better support her there, and well as guide her on her journey toward college.


