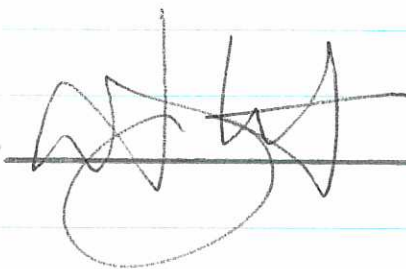
Dear OSA
