Dear OSAA;

The life that I was born into was simple, just working on the farm and going to school. The house was a one room building for a family of five, we shared everything and that was not a problem. Now, as I have been in Oregon for eight years, it is simply a life of joy. I have privileges such as my own room and the freedom to participate in many activities and make career choices.

Coming from China and not speaking English was my most difficult obstacle to overcome. I learned endurance and self-control as I had to go to school and no one else spoke my language, so I had no translator. Not only did I not speak English, but I have had to have many surgeries to fix my cleft palate which affects my speech and hearing. Just learning how to pronounce certain words has been problematic for me. Overcoming these complications has given me confidence and the self-assurance that I will not only finish high school with an honors diploma, but earn a college degree because I understand the effort that is required to do so. I am involved in a multitude of community service project.

I like to challenge myself by trying new things. Due to this, I would like to try and play tennis this year. I have never played tennis before, but it is a goal I want to try. I hope you approve my application. Please let me know if you have questions.

Dear Committee Members,

I am writing on behalf of my son, Max Hurtado, who would like to participate on the tennis team at Henley High school this season. Max will be ineligible to participate in sports this season due to his age, which is what I would like to petition you for your consideration.

Max was born on May 31, 1996 and spent the first twelve years of his life in an orphanage in China. My husband and I adopted him and brought him to the United States when he was twelve. When he arrived in the United States, he spoke no English and had a very minimal formal educational background. Physically, he was small for his age. We enrolled him as a fourth grader in the fall of 2008 and found that he fit in with this age group developmentally. His second year in the US, we enrolled him in a blended 5th/6th grade classroom, and then continued with that group as a 7th grader his third year. Now at nineteen, and after eight years in the US, Max is a senior at Henley.

Max has worked diligently to make the most of every opportunity that he has been offered. He will be graduating this spring, eighth in his class with a 3.96 cumulative GPA, an Honor's Diploma, and 49 units of college credit. He has participated in both community and school activities as a volunteer and a team member. As a freshman and sophomore, Max ran on the cross country and track teams. Although he didn't make the basketball team freshman year, he volunteered to work as team manager. Max has continued to serve in this position throughout his four years at Henley and has been recognized by both coaches and players as a vital part of the team.

Max has also been involved in our community with the 4-H program for the eight years he has been here. He competes in both non-animal and animal projects. In addition to volunteering as a teen leader in his 4-H clubs, Max has also helps to tutor students in math and works in the children's ministry program at his church.

While balancing his activities with his school work, Max has endured twelve surgeries. He was born with a bilateral cleft palate which has taken multiple surgeries to repair. His congenital defects also included a hole in his eardrum which has caused him to require a hearing aid. He has struggled to not only learn the English language, but also to overcome a speech and stuttering impediment.

This last year, Max has started playing tennis. He has enjoyed learning the sport, but mostly enjoys being involved as part of a team. He strongly desires to participate on the Henley High tennis team this year, and I would like to ask your committee to consider him for a hardship release to allow him the opportunity to finish his high school career with another positive experience.
