Dear Lynn:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). After carefully reviewing all of the information that you have submitted, I have concluded that eligibility should not be granted at this time.

Eligibility is denied because the student has failed to demonstrate sufficient academic achievement at this time, and the student has not established this deficiency is due to circumstances beyond the control of each of the student and the student's parent(s). The student has only passed 1 class and 2 classes respectively in his last 2 semesters. His current grade check shows that he is only passing 2 of 7 classes as of 3/9/16. Therefore, eligibility is denied.

The student needs to work hard to pass his classes this semester and complete his credit recovery over the summer so that he is back on track toward graduation by the start of the 2016-17 school year. If the school wishes to resubmit this request at a future date, then eligibility would be reconsidered at that time.

You have a right to appeal my decision to the OSAA Executive Board. If you would like to schedule an appeal, please forward a written request to the OSAA office. As per OSAA Executive Board Policy "Eligibility Appeal Filing Fee", there is a non-refundable \$100.00 filing fee to defray the costs of the appeal.
