Dear Ben:

I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). I have carefully reviewed all of the information that you have submitted, and I have concluded that eligibility should be granted because the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) team has determined that the student is making adequate educational progress towards meeting the goals and objectives outlined in the IEP.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school to ensure that the student is attending school regularly (NO unexcused absences), participates in credit recovery courses now and during the summer to make up missing credits, and continues to meet the goals and objectives of her Individualized Education Program (IEP) each week so that she is passing at least 5 classes. If the student fails to meet these goals and objectives at any time, then eligibility is revoked.
