
Appeals Process

Appeals of decisions made by the District Athletic Committee are heard by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board. Appeals must be requested in writing, or e-mail, and submitted to the OSAA Executive Director.

Any party filing an appeal of a decision made by the District Athletic Committee to the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board shall be assessed a filing fee of \$100 to defray the costs to the Association of assembling the respective appeals bodies to hear the appeal.

If a waiver is denied by the OSAA Eligibility Appeals Board, an appeal can be made to a Hearings Officer under OSAA Handbook Rule 9, "Hearings Officer." Appeals to the Hearings Officer shall include an appeal fee of \$250.

Victoria is a senior at Madison High School transferring from Arizona. Her inclusion in Track and Field at Madison will help her feel included in the Madison community. It can be difficult, I imagine, to transfer in the middle of your senior year of high school, and into a completely new region of the country.

To Whom It May Concern,

I have been acting as guardian for Victoria DuCharme (DOB 06/09/1998). Victoria is my maternal first cousin. She has been living with me at 6101 NE Fremont St., Portland Oregon 97213 since January 5th, 2016. I have lived at this address since March 2011. This letter serves as an explanation of the circumstances by which Victoria came to live with me.

Victoria's previous address was 2235 Running Iron Lane, Cottonwood Arizona. Victoria lived there with her mother, Christy DuCharme, who continues to reside there. While residing at 2235 Running Iron Lane, Victoria attended Mingus Union High School where she ran Cross Country as recently as Fall 2015.

Christy DuCharme contacted me on December 21st, 2015 to see if I would be willing to care for Victoria for the indefinite future. The call was precipitated by several months of interpersonal conflict between Victoria and Christy. As I understand it, Christy was unhappy Victoria's choice of boyfriend; her demands that Victoria stop communicating with the boyfriend spiraled out of control, resulting in a unhealthy battle of wills between Victoria and Christy. Because Christy is physically fragile and mentally ill (extreme anxiety; depression; possible substance abuse; and house bound, with the exception of doctor appointments, the vast majority of the time), Christy decided that it would be better if Victoria moved away. Victoria left Cottonwood, Arizona shortly before Christmas to visit family in California. While she was in California, Christy made arrangement for Victoria to fly to Portland. Victoria never returned to Arizona, instead arriving in Portland, Oregon on January 5th, 2016. I enrolled her at Madison, my neighborhood public high school, the second or third week of January 2016; she began attending Madison at the start of the 2nd semester. Victoria will be graduating from Madison in June 2016.
