I have received the Eligibility Request Form that you have submitted for the above student requesting a waiver of OSAA Rule 8.1.2 (Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation). I have carefully reviewed all of the information that you have submitted, and I have concluded that eligibility should be granted because the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) team has determined that the student is making adequate educational progress towards meeting the goals and objectives outlined in the IEP.

Conditions of this eligibility shall be weekly monitoring by the school to ensure that the student attends school regularly (no unexcused absences) and is meeting the requirements and objectives of her Individualized Education Program (IEP) so that she is back on track toward graduation by the start of the 2016-17 school year. The student may need to participate in credit recovery courses over the summer in order to achieve her goal of graduating in June 2018. If the student fails to meet these goals and objectives at any time, then eligibility is revoked. Any request for future eligibility would have to be resubmitted to this office for consideration.

It is our sincere hope that the student will benefit from this waiver.
