4. **ADMISSION:**

- A. **Ticket Prices:** *Student is any child age 5 & up through a senior in high school.*

First & Second Rounds (School Sites) through Semifinals	Adults – \$10	Students – \$6
Championship Games – General Admission	Adults – \$12	Students – \$6
Finals Site – All Session Tickets, General Admission	Adults – <b>\$32</b>	Students – <b>\$18</b>

- B. Digital tickets may be purchased through [HomeTown Ticketing on the OSAA website, www.osaa.org/shop/tickets, through the OSAA Live Mobile App, or www.osaa.org/app](#).

Tickets for future games will be posted as soon as possible after a matchup is announced. Follow the OSAA on Facebook and Twitter for notification on when tickets are available.

- C. **Finals Site:**

1) Gates open **one hour** prior to each session.

- D. **Complimentary Tickets:** Each school that participates in a state championship match will receive the following complimentary tickets: Superintendent, 2; Principal, 2; Athletic Director, 2.

1) The host school is to provide these tickets for all matches prior to the finals site.

2) The OSAA office will provide these tickets at the finals site at the participant table entrance.

- E. **Gate Lists:** Gate lists at home sites in excess of the complimentary ticket allotments mentioned above shall not be used. Every person in attendance must have a ticket or a pass in order to enter.

- F. **Bus Drivers:** *Schools are responsible for all bus driver admissions.* The OSAA does not provide passes for bus drivers.

- G. **Passes:** ONLY the OSAA Gold Card, OSAA VIP, OSAA Media passes, and Volleyball Media passes, which will admit the bearer only with photo ID, are to be honored at any OSAA State Championship event. No school, athletic district, officials association, etc., passes are to be accepted.

Team expenses will be paid by check at the conclusion of the fall sports season according to the 2025-26 Reimbursement Formula.

7. **CHEERLEADING SQUADS:** Complimentary admission will be given to 12 varsity cheerleading members in uniform (plus one advisor) during the session in which their school is playing. Please be reminded that cheerleaders are expected to remain in the designated student seating area during matches.

8. **RULE 3 – CONTESTS – SPORTSMANSHIP – CROWD CONTROL** (OSAA Handbook, Rules)

9. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – BROADCASTING/STREAMING** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) ([OSAA for Media](#)) (Revised July 2019)

A. The OSAA owns the broadcasting / streaming rights to all state championship events, first round through the championship finals. Radio and television stations, cable companies, websites and social media accounts planning to broadcast / stream games in any round of the OSAA state championships must register with the OSAA by submitting an online Registration Form. Registered and approved broadcasts / streams will be listed on the OSAA State Championship Broadcast Schedule. Those not listed will not be allowed.

B. For OSAA state championship events hosted by member schools, it shall be the responsibility of those registered and approved to contact the host school's athletic director to arrange for space, power and Internet access if available. The OSAA will coordinate these arrangements at all final sites and semifinal sites for football only.

C. NOTE: The NFHS Network is the exclusive video broadcast rights holder of OSAA state championship events. Live and on-demand video of OSAA state championship events (full or condensed versions) is strictly prohibited and in direct violation of the OSAA's agreement with the NFHS Network. Those registered and approved for broadcasting / streaming state championship events declined by the NFHS Network shall pay a rights fee to the OSAA.

D. Video highlights are limited to a total of two minutes per game, including broadcasts, streams and social media posts

10. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – VIDEOTAPING** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) ([OSAA for Media](#)) (Revised July 2019)

Recording video of state championships from seating area is allowed provided the view of spectators is not obstructed. Use of a tripod in seating area is prohibited due to safety reasons. An official school video recorder, identified prior to an OSAA state championship event by the head coach or athletic director of a participating school, will be allowed in a designated area established by the OSAA.

NOTE: Recording video is for private use only. Broadcasting or streaming video - live or delay - is prohibited unless an online registration form has been submitted and approved by the OSAA. Those approved for broadcasting / streaming OSAA state championship events declined by the NFHS Network shall pay a rights fee to the OSAA.

11. **WITHDRAWAL FROM STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Revised Fall 2008)

By entering participants in a state championship meet, contest or tournament, each member school certifies that, barring injury, illness or unforeseen events, or a withdrawal to avoid violating the religious convictions of team members, the team or individuals representing the school will participate in every game or competition, that is part of that championship event, until the final conclusion of the meet, contest or championship. Any withdrawal or intentional forfeiture for reasons other than those specified shall be considered a sportsmanship violation, and shall be subject to reprimand and/or other penalties as determined by the Executive Board. ### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – TEAM SIZE** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Revised Fall 2013)
  - A. The following limitations shall apply to replacement players and maximum team sizes for team sport State Championship events, first round through championship final. **NOTE:** Only players in uniform are allowed to participate in pre-game warm-ups.
  - B. **Penalties for excessive team size:** Suiting up, warming up, or playing too many players shall be considered a gross act of unsportsmanlike conduct and may be punishable by fines, forfeiture and/or other penalties as determined by the OSAA Executive Board.
    - 6) **Volleyball.** Team: Replacement of players applies to each match. A player replaced on the roster may be reinstated to the roster in subsequent matches. Maximum in uniform: 6A – **16**; All other classifications – **14**.
2. **UNIFORMS:** The current NFHS rules apply. Please be certain the school uniforms are legal per NFHS rules.
3. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – ADOPTED BALL** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Fall 2010)

The OSAA shall require that the officially adopted ball for that sport be used in all state championship contests, first round through final sites.

  - A. **State Championship Contests at Home Sites.**
    - 1) **Team sports (other than football).**
      - a) **Procedure.** Officials shall confirm that the game balls provided by the home team are the officially adopted balls (Wilson **Nova** multi-colored). If the home team does not have the officially adopted ball, officials shall inquire if the visiting team has the officially adopted ball and use them if they are available. If neither team has the officially adopted ball, the contest shall be played, and officials shall report the violation by the host school to the OSAA.
      - b) **Penalty.** If no officially adopted balls are available for use at an OSAA state championship contest, the host school shall be subject to fines, forfeiture and/or other penalties as determined by the OSAA Executive Board.
  - B. **State Championship Contests Administered by OSAA Staff.** Officially adopted balls (Wilson K1 Gold; white or multi-colored) shall be provided by OSAA staff administering the contests. OSAA Final Site – OSAA will provide multi-colored balls.
4. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – MEDICAL CHAIN OF COMMAND** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Effective Fall 2012)

The OSAA provides an official medical team that consists of State of Oregon registered athletic trainers and/or licensed physicians at state championship events administered by OSAA staff whenever possible. If provided, this OSAA designated medical team shall have final authority on all injury evaluations, participation status and return-to-play decisions.

### **FIRST AND SECOND (1A) ROUNDS**

1. **EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (December 2015): [www.anyonecansavealife.org](http://www.anyonecansavealife.org)

Each full member school shall have an Emergency Action Plan (EAP) in place for responding to life-threatening emergencies in after-school practices and events. Schools are strongly encouraged to utilize the “Anyone Can Save a Life” program, a free, turnkey solution that covers all medical emergencies.
2. **MATCH LOCATIONS, DATES AND TIMES:** Refer to brackets for locations and home team designation. Matches are to be played on the dates indicated on the brackets. Schools have the option, by mutual agreement, to change Saturday matches to Friday. If schools cannot mutually agree, the match will remain as scheduled on the OSAA calendar. Match times are by mutual agreement of both participating schools. If schools cannot mutually agree, the OSAA will make the final decision. Schools are to log on to the OSAA website to enter their match time for each playoff round prior to the final site. A location for the match should only be added when the match isn’t being played at the host school’s campus.
3. **OFFICIALS:**
  - A. **First Round:** The host school is to obtain two officials and two line judges from the association that services its home matches. OSAA will pay the officials and line judges through Arbiter Pay. See OSAA Handbook, [Executive Board Policy, Officials – Host School Responsibilities](#) for additional information.
  - B. **Second (6A, 3A and 1A only):** Two officials and two line judges will be assigned and paid by OSAA through Arbiter Pay. Officials have been instructed to contact the host school AD to reconfirm match times and locations prior to the day of the contest.

4. **MATCH FORMAT:** All matches will be best three out of five sets to 25 points, win by two points with no cap. Fifth set will be to 15 points, win by two points with no cap.
5. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS - HOME TEAM DESIGNATION** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Revised Fall 2018)  
During all rounds of each OSAA State Championship bracket, the team with the better Adjusted Playoff Ranking (APR) shall be the designated home team.
6. **PRACTICE TIME:** Practice time will not be available.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP SITE INFORMATION – Eastern Oregon University, La Grande High School**

1. **CHAMPIONSHIP SITE:** OSAA Championship Office (November 7-8), Missy Smith, Phone: 503.682.6722 x227
2. **COACHES MEETING:** *November 5 - via Zoom. An email will be sent to qualifying teams, and the coach and administrator from each team is required to attend.*
3. **COACHES' PACKETS:** Packets will be available at the championship site when teams arrive and check in at participant entry desk. Each packet will contain 17 participant passes, including coaches and athletic trainer.
  - A. No additional passes will be available at the championship site. Coaches may gain admission with their OSAA Gold Card and photo ID.
  - B. The OSAA does not provide passes for bus drivers.
4. **PARKING AND ENTRANCE:** *See Campus Map*

### **La Grande**

- A. **Team Parking and Entrance:** Buses drop off teams at the South side of La Grande High School near the gymnasium, between the gymnasium and Central Elementary school off 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. Parking for team buses along the fence that is marked Bus Only Parking.
  - 1) There is ample parking available on the south side of the building and also on the West side of the building off K Street.
  - 2) There is no overnight RV parking allowed on the La Grande High School campus.

### **Eastern Oregon**

- B. **Team Parking and Entrance:** Buses drop off teams on G Avenue behind Quinn Coliseum. Bus parking along the sidewalk marked Bus Parking.
  - 1) There is ample parking available on the EOU campus off 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenues.
  - 2) There is no overnight RV parking allowed on the EOU campus.
5. **PRACTICE:** Practice time will not be available onsite. A minimum of 20 minutes warm up time (4-8-8) will be allowed on court prior to match time. Stretching and warm-up must be done across the parking lot from La Grande High School in the Central Elementary gym, and in the practice gym at EOU. Teams in the first match of a session may stretch on court and balls will be provided 1 hour prior to match time.
6. **MATCH FORMAT:** All matches will be best three out of five sets to 25 points, win by two points with no cap. Fifth set will be to 15 points, win by two points with no cap.
7. **TEAM ROSTERS:** A written roster (14 players only) shall be submitted at the coaches meeting prior to each match. Changes can be made to the roster up to ten minutes prior to the first set. Line-ups are due 2 minutes prior to the first set and one minute prior to subsequent sets.
8. **SCORE TABLE STAFFING:** The OSAA will provide the Scorer, Timer and Libero Tracker for each match at the finals site (not the first and second rounds).
9. **TOWELS:** Towels will not be available or issued at the championship site.
10. **WATER JUGS TO FILL UP WATER BOTTLES:** The OSAA will provide a water jug at each bench during the State Championship finals. The coolers will contain water and ice. To prevent spills, open cups will not be permitted on the court. Water bottles are permitted.

**11. STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – MEDICAL CHAIN OF COMMAND** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies) (Effective Fall 2012)

The OSAA provides an official medical team that consists of State of Oregon registered athletic trainers and/or licensed physicians at state championship events administered by OSAA staff whenever possible. If provided, this OSAA designated medical team shall have final authority on all injury evaluations, participation status and return-to-play decisions.

**12. ATHLETIC TRAINER:** On call at each site. Teams must provide their own first aid supplies.

**13. SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD:** This award will be presented to the school that displays the best overall sportsmanship both on and off the court. The school, coaches, players, cheerleading squads and spectators are all considered in the judging. A special committee will choose which school is to receive this honor.

**14. ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING / ENTRY:**

A. There are six ADA Accessible parking spaces available near the baseball diamond and four ADA Accessible parking spaces available near the roundabout (see campus map).

B. Ticket booths and gates are ADA accessible.

**15. SERVICE ANIMALS:** Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness, and be in full control of the handler, at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.

**16. LOST AND FOUND:** During the event, Lost & Found will be at the OSAA Event Office or other location designated by the host facility / OSAA Staff. Beginning the first business day after the event, please email [kathif@osaa.org](mailto:kathif@osaa.org) to claim any missing items. Property owner is responsible for any costs associated with the property return. Property will be held for 30 days. If no owner is located or property is unclaimed after 30 days, the property will be donated to a charitable organization or disposed of.

**17. AWARDS:** Team trophies will be presented at the conclusion of each trophy match on Saturday. The sportsmanship award, all-tournament team recognition, second place and championship trophies and medals and championship bracket board will be presented at the conclusion of each classification's final match Saturday evening.

A. **Trophies:** Champion through sixth place trophies will be presented to the top teams in each classification.

B. **Medals:** Seventeen medals will be presented to both the champion and second place teams in each classification.

C. **OSAA All-Tournament Teams:** Medals will be presented to members of the All-Tournament 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams in each classification (six members on each team).

D. **Moda Health Player of the Match:** One player from each team in each classification's championship final match will be recognized as that team's Moda Health Player of the Game. As part of the post-game awards and medals presentation, the winners will be invited on to the court to receive a commemorative item from Moda Health and the OSAA.

**18. FALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATES:**

Schools can create certificates for each of their student participants. Access is limited to OSAA website user accounts with school administrative access (ADs, Athletic Secretaries, Principals, etc.).


